EcoRegió Catalunya

EcoRegion is the economic community for organic food. Farmers, local citizens, governments and universities promote the ecological enterprises of their own region with micro-capital and participate in the regional economical dynamization as shareholders. The supported value chain of production, commercialization, distribution and services generates economic, social and environmental benefits for the region. This balanced return enables small and medium sized farms and producers to survive in a highly competitive market while allowing local supply chains and synergies to strengthen the region's sustainable values and consumers to enjoy ecological alimentation.

In Germany the Regionalwert AG is already successful: 700 investors support 20 companies with more than 150 workers and 30 trainees with a capital of € 3 million.

The project is especially directed to create new green jobs: it was selected by Ashoka as one of 12 projects that can create employment in Spain, Portugal and Greece.

The objective of EcoRegió is to create a network of MicroEcoRegions with methodologies of economic, social and environmental impact.
